ANNUAL MEETING, WILLIAMSBURG, VIRGINIA

The annual meeting of the American Mosquito Control Association will be held at the Conference Center, Williamsburg, Virginia, February 23–26, 1969.

The Board of Directors will meet on February 23 from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. There will be a "Happy Hour" for all delegates in the North Gallery from 6:00

p.m. to 7:00 p.m.

On Monday morning, February 24, the convention will be called to order in the Auditorium at 9:00 a.m. This will be a general session with Harold Atkinson, President of the Virginia Mosquito Control Association, presiding. After the invocation and address of welcome, there will be a keynote address followed by the President's address by Thomas D. Mulhern. After a coffee break, the program will continue until noon with invitational papers.

The afternoon session will consist of submitted papers in the Auditorium. From 8:00–10:00 p.m. there will be an informal symposium in the Auditorium.

There will be morning and afternoon sessions for submitted papers in the Auditorium on Tuesday, February 25. The Commissioners will have a breakfast at 8:30, followed by a special program for the Commissioners. From 6:30–7:30 p.m. there will be a cocktail hour in the North Gallery, followed by the annual banquet. Dr. Carl S. Winters has been obtained

for the principal speaker through the courtesy of General Motors.

On Wednesday morning at 8:00 a.m. the annual business meeting of the American Mosquito Control Association will be held, followed by morning and afternoon sessions. There will be a final meeting of the Board of Directors from 4:00 to 5:00 p.m.

Arrangements have been made for coffee breaks between the morning and afternoon sessions at which time there will be drawings for door prizes.

Special arrangements are being made for the ladies. It is anticipated that there will be plenty to occupy the ladies' time visiting the historical places of interest. A convenient golf course is also available.

There will be two exhibit rooms and also exhibit space in a nearby parking lot for equipment too big to show inside.

The weather at Williamsburg in February can be very pleasant—mild and clear. This, however, cannot be guaranteed.

Williamsburg is thirty miles west of Norfolk, fifty miles east of Richmond, and 150 miles south of Washington. By air it is fifteen miles from Patrick Henry Airport, with limousine service to Williamsburg.
