### ANNOUNCEMENT—1970 SOUTH PACIFIC REGIONAL MEETING

An especially attractive feature for 1970 is the plan of the *South Pacific Region* to hold a Regional Meeting immediately following the AMCA Meeting in Portland, February 22-25, 1970.

Timetable of the Meeting is travel to Honolulu February 26, full-day meeting Friday, February 27, which will include paper presentations and a short business meeting. Field study of mosquito control operations under the auspices of the State of Hawaii Health Department will be by arrangement Saturday and/or the following Monday.

Arrangements are being made to include a short tour for those interested.
