## The Sénevet Collection at the Paris Museum\*

The microscopic preparations belonging to G. Sénevet, a well known specialist of Diptera, Culicidae, have been deposited in the National Museum of Natural History by M. E. Abonnenc. The collection includes more than a thousand slides and includes especially the types of species described by G. Sénevet in the genera *Limatus*, *Wyeomyia*, *Culex* and *Anopheles*. It is necessary to note with regret that the mounting medium used has rendered a great number of preparations scarcely usable and the labelling of many others leaves something to be desired. The collection remains however, especially because of its types, a requisition for the Laboratory of Entomology of the Museum that is not negligible.
