

EDITOR'S CORNER

Contained in this issue are corrections and additions to the AMCA publication, "Identification and Geographical Distribution of the Mosquitoes of North America, North of Mexico" by R. A. Ward and R. F. Darsie, Jr. This paper, in addition to correcting errors which appeared in the book, lists 21 new state and province records for the U. S. and Canada, adds 67 references (from 1979 to mid 1982) to the bibliography, and clarifies the status of several species. Anyone who has purchased this book may obtain a reprint of the article by sending a request to the AMCA office in Fresno, California.

Contributors to Mosquito Systematics are reminded that each submitted manuscript is usually sent to at least two reviewers. This requires that an original plus two copies must be enclosed regardless of the length of the manuscript. This requirement may be waived in the case of "Camera ready" copies which have already been reviewed by referees approved by the editor.

A Mosquito Systematics Symposium is being planned for the AMCA meeting at Lake Buena Vista, Florida, in 1983. The panel which will be moderated by Tom Zavortink will include several papers on subjects of considerable current interest to workers in the field.
