

EDITORS CORNER

In the last issue I reported that Mosquito Systematics will take on a new format with Volume 22, 1990 in which all papers will be published in a two column style comparable to that used in the Journal of the AMCA. All manuscripts now submitted must conform to the following procedure.

1. All papers will be submitted in printed form to the Editor in triplicate as previously required and accompanied by the illustrative material. Original copies of illustrations which will require reduction in size may be sent directly to the Lake Charles office to reduce chance of loss in transit. Copies, however, must be sent to the Editor with the manuscript.
2. Exceptions to No. 1 will be papers which have been thoroughly reviewed before submission, and are sent in a Camera Ready form. These will be sent with the paper transcribed on a 3 1/2" or 5" diskette (3 1/2" preferred) and one copy of the paper in a printed form accompanied by copies of the illustrations.
3. All papers will be submitted to reviewers. This will generally be two individuals expert in the field of Mosquito Systematics.
4. As soon as manuscripts are returned from reviewers they will be returned to the authors with the reviewer's and editor's comments. Manuscripts accepted for publication will then be corrected or revised by the author to their final form. These will then be submitted to the editor with the paper transcribed on a diskette (as noted in No. 2 above) accompanied by 1 printed copy of the corrected manuscript. Request for reprints will be made at this time on the form provided.
5. Authors who do not have facilities to submit their corrected manuscripts on diskettes will return them to the editor in printed form. (Printed form is defined as single-spaced, courier 12-pitch or similar typeface. Justified text is unacceptable. There should be absolutely no handwriting on the pages). They will then be transcribed by the Lake Charles office. These authors will then be charged a small processing charge (\$2.00 per page).
6. The diskettes containing the transcribed corrected copy of the manuscript along with one printed copy and the illustrative material will then be sent by the Editor to the AMCA office at Lake Charles for final assembling and printing into the two column format.

7. The individual manuscripts in this format will then be mailed to the authors for final proofing.
8. When all papers have been returned to the Lake Charles office, the appropriate issue will be assembled and a collated, unbound copy will be sent to the Editor for final approval. Issues will then be completed and mailed to subscribers from the Lake Charles office.
9. These instructions and information of page charges and reprints will be printed as before on the inside back cover of the journal.

In the last issue of Mosquito Systematics Vol 21, No. 2, September, 1989 we published the obituary and list of publications of Dr. Valery Danilov. Publication No. 61, of that list, "Moustiques de France. Bibliographie et repartition" was apparently a "book review" of that paper. The actual author was Odile Moussiégt, Documentaliste of the Entante Interdepartementale pour la Demoustication du Littoral Mediterranéen, Montpellier, France.
