## 1965-66 LECTURE SERIES

"PLANT COLLECTING IN THE ANDES OF PERU" with Mr. Paul Hutchison, Senior Botanist at the Botanical Gardens of the University of California at Berkeley, will be the first lecture sponsored by the Foundation on September 17, 1965, 8:00 P. M., in the Lecture Hall at the Arboretum.

This lecture will be illustrated with colored slides taken by Mr. Hutchison during his travels into remote areas of Chile, Peru and Bolivia. In 1963 through 1964, Mr. Hutchison was Director of the University of California Botanical Garden's Seventh Expedition to the Andes, collecting some 4,400 plants, 30,000 herbarium specimens, besides seeds, living plants and bulbs. This trip was financially supported by donations from various groups, including California Arboretum Foundation, Inc.
