Liewen Thomas says, "I started in Creative Plant Design as a way to be involved at the Arboretum, never realizing how much joy I would get from working with the succulents." Joanne Sanders adds, "The group is wonderful and I have learned so much. I still remember the day I first visited the work area. When I saw the beautiful succulent wreaths being created there, I knew I had found a perfect fit."

Creative Plant Design supplies the Arboretum Garden Gift Shop and plant sales with these popular living sculptures. Last year, customers purchased a total of \$10,000 worth of these arrangements at the shop and LA Garden Show. Prices range from \$35 for wreaths to \$100 for elaborate arrangements that could include a Mexican palm frond planted with succulents.

"It is so rewarding to be able to use our interests and talents to support the Garden Gift Shop and other Arboretum events," says Liewen. "My experiences here have really enriched my life."
