


DESCRIPTION OF *MARGINELLA LATERITIA*, n.sp., FROM THE  
ANDAMAN ISLANDS.

*MARGINELLA (GLABELLA) LATERITIA*, n.sp.

M. testa ovato-fusiformi, laevissima, nitidiuscula, solida, spira conica, obtusa, anfractibus 5, quorum  $2\frac{1}{2}$  vel 3 subhyalini, apicales, cæteris perlævibus, albo-cinereis, anfractu ultimo apud medium late et pallide rufozonato, omnibus spiraliter notulatis et concinne castaneo-maculatis, apertura angusta, oblonga, labro crassiusculo, nitido, hic illuc castaneo-zonulato, intus multidenticulato, columella quadriplicata. Long. 6, at. 3·5 mm.



*Marginella lateritia*, n.sp.

*Hab.*—Ad insulas Andamanenses.

This particularly interesting little species has no immediate ally in the genus, so far as its pattern of ornamental painting is concerned, if we except *M. picturata*, Nevill, from Mauritius. That, however, is a smaller shell still. The neatly arranged spiral zones and dotting, producing a fanciful resemblance to layers of masonry, suggested the trivial name.
