Orono, Me, Jon. 30, 1890. Dr. Nalson, Dear Lie: looking at Juneus, hole, which I sent you in the fall, and am more and more convinced that it is not described in the Mounal. I send you a Specimen with more materie fruit than any I sent before, I think. I seems to me something like J. tennis, var. secunder, but the flowers are not restricted to one side of the pouricle. I have an interesting larey which I had not determined

when I last wrote you -C. communia, vor. Wheeleris. Prof. Bailey has verified my naming of st. Respectfully yours, Merritt L. Fernald.
