never mentioned in Hooker!! He  
mixes all doubt, about a plant of  
Gregg's and one of Fendler, Santa  
Fe Specimen, mixed with Bellingham,  
Kunth's fruticosa also makes its  
appearance and is a good  
specimen which I had all along  
distinguished under the provisional  
name of I. acquiragus, but have  
not seen from Boston - not nearer  
to it than Lancaster (Porter)

Oh I only had paradoxus now!
