Dear professor.

I have send enclosed a twig of  
of Reverchon bearing males and females  
floriferous! our plant is decidedly monocious,  
the males appear in clusters in the axils of leaves,  
the females are isolated. ~~from~~ my observations: ~~that~~  
the male flower. there is a calice of 4 divisions, and  
4 stamens united by pair or didelphous; this last  
character, will, it seems to me, make a good  
distinction from the genus Phyllanthus to  
which it seems closely related.

I hope you will find the twig enclosed  
sufficient for establishing the character of the genus.  
if not I would send you green specimens  
if I know how? or put in sketch if  
preferable?
