Jungermannia <sup>above</sup> those species that  
will best illustrate the different  
sections, or suggest other ones,

made here. I omit, <sup>from the list</sup> however,  
Lundaria, as merely an introduced  
plant, & Diplophyllum, as not  
yet found in our territory.

Do you object to the use of  
perianth in place of inner involucre?  
I see that Sprengel uses it, & it is  
much less cumbersome.

I would write *Ceph. multiflora*,  
hindb. ~~Asper~~ <sup>That</sup> Sprengel corrected  
Hindberg's description is hardly suf-  
ficient reason for citing him as au-  
thority for the species. This is a gener-  
ally accepted principle.

*Porella dentata* is the oldest name  
for the species under the genus. Hind-  
berg should rather have taken the spe-  
cific name *viridula*, but he did not  
do it, and it is only making synonymous to  
do it now. *Asper* <sup>very</sup> *dentata*
