long leafy spike from Empire Co
& one from the plains.
I think I would be well
to have a miscellaneous set
of the more choice plants
with you to select for Hooker
and others. Don't know what
Hall may think of it. He
might object to my doing it
as contrary to our agreement
by which I am bound not to

sell any over plus in my
hands for a year -

I am glad you are going to
take hold of the *Setragalia*
you will find Hall's collection
rich in flowering specimens

Not a word from Engelmann
the last two weeks I sent
him your notes on Camp.

Nothing yet from Heale, I
expect he finds his bulky
collection quite a job to
unravel I hope to get this
week from him my set of
plants so as to know what
to send to complete the set

A letter has gone to Pike's Peak
for that "Pond Lily" expect to get
a capsule this winter -

I think I should prefer
to sell the rest of my pine
seeds in this country, where
they would be more of a

novelty - If the Rochester
men will take them at a
fair price I will send them
the whole stock. The main bulk
is *A. Menziesii* well adapted
to that locality -

Has Hall written you about
seeds? he was collecting quite
largely, but in small quantities
each species. he left too
early for pine seeds

I send a seed *C. canif.*
sent me by a correspondent
from across the range too
little to make much of -
I have enough copies of
Strophium. Engelmann
sent on a parcel. If you
can send me 12-15 copies
of revision *Pentstemon* please
do so. I hope you will get
Hall's in time. several nice
ones in the collection, before we
