I cannot conceive what he is about this
long time now 16 days since I wrote advising
him of your description & my acceptance.
Your experience will be different from mine
if you get on smoothly. He is so obstinate &
self opinionated. I think he will want to
number irrespective of my published list and so
make confusion and extra work. I want
to bring out some general views of distribution
of plants when I get a full set & how about
labels. I suppose you would advise me form
including all these collectors? How would it do to
define boundaries by Lat & Long. as in Mex B.D.? }
