Dear Mr. Gray I have just reached
Denver, and lodged in the express office
as per receipt 5 sacks of conifer seed
or 2 Boxes of Plants No 7. of which
I have notified you the contents of
Box 12. packed only yesterday, included
gentiana affinis. Ergem. macrocarpa
E. glabellum Nordmannia saginata
X Abies Douglasii & A. Engel.
All these parcels will start to night
& be in your hands next week
I have on hand all the seed collected
since Box No 2. of which with the
addition here I will make a parcel
& send or take with me. I shall
start Saturday even for Denver
May go & see Greene
