My dear Dr Gray

Mr Watson's
letter of 14th to hand. General

I enclose P.O. order for \$7.00 to
cover cost.

I staid a Day with Engelmann
on my return he put me on
the track of Androstaphium. but
did not examine critically to
see if distinct from A. violaceum
I would like to have got some
bulbs for cultivation but I was
on horseback out of the settlements
and no means for digging there.
It has a light hyacinthine color,
spreading perianth, showing the
corona embracing the stamens.

I am ordered to report at Ft. Bridger before June 8th.
Young Putnam has gone on in advance to take stationary observations. I think on the whole I shall prefer this trip to the big one, as we go direct into the high mountains, and waste no time on the plains & "bad lands," good for fossils, but not so good for live things.
I wish Watson could go and meet us out there somewhere. I hear again from Beckhouse some more undescribed wants. I shall try & get Lemiscrinum for him & good stock & send by mail a specimen from Denver or Cheyenne. I shall try & arrange to leave the exp'd¹ in left early enough to collect rocks & cuttings at Buena & some other good place and

will engage help to make a big file, if it can be satisfactorily arranged. Mr. P. will come out to Colorado to meet me, in company with Mr. Putnam, and we will take the Rock house by storm. I have some sorts of Abronia fragrans, shooting up that I left out all winter by way of experiment.

When can I get a copy of "Baker's revision of Liliaceae"?

I expect to leave here about 27th inst & go direct to Denver.
