Mr. B. in the course of our
conversations, has often mentioned
the difficulty he has experienced in
obtaining a good specimen of the
fossiliferous limestone of the
Caspian Sea. He has been
unable to find any in the
districts of Tiflis, Batum, or
Tbilissi, and has only
seen one at Batum, which
was obtained from a
locality near the village
of Krasnogorsk, about
10 miles from Batum.
The limestone is
thin bedded, light
brown, and contains
abundant fossiliferous
fragments of coral, brachiopods,
and other marine
invertebrates.
