Please ask Watson to run over the Phacelia,
of which I think are or may be 8. 3 others
new in coll. P. Fremontii, P. crenulata &
P. Palmeri. Seed of most of them

By same road that takes me I leave
it going westward expect to reach
Salt Lake about July 20th, Denver
July 26th & Dawson July 28th. I shall
stop at Dawson about 2 weeks to
partly sort up my collection & seeds &
return to Colorado to complete collection
of seeds & roots for Bradt house, Nai
will be the year for Cupressus.

I have been picking up odds & ends
among other things & get full material
for Archmeaeum — in N. Amer. Paper. my
collection is partly packed & would send
you in my parcel. Also a Loasacean
Eucnide — ? in which the petals
cohere & fall off in a ring. with monodelphic
stamens. perhaps we can make a
Cambylos out of it.

I am well satisfied with my
collection so far very complete & in
excellent condition. I expect to pick
up some nice things on the route up will
stop 10 days in 2 weeks at Cedar City
Worth to Salt Lake up to July 10th after
to Dawson
