My dear Dr. Gray
Yours of 17th
just received. I write to
catch you at Washington

I think you will find in
Agr. Dept. Herb. a pretty full
set of Palmer's Utah
Phacelia's that may perhaps
help out the determinations
All the species seem quite
distinct in the field. The color
of fl. when clear and well
marked is not inclined to
vary especially in 182, deep blue
180. bright blue. 176. light dull blue
So I am sorry you had not
taken seeds of all these. From
the Beckhous collection as
I intended and so did not save
out

On account of being cut off
from free travel this year
on Kansas Pacific R.R.
I now think I may push
directly for Utah & work among
the high Wahsatch. Mr. Steba
& I through the summer &
then go down to the flange
to winter (my wife joining me)
then arrange for an early
spring tour on the Lower Colorado
Bill Williams &c. and work
north as the season advances.
If I can carry out this
plan satisfactorily I think
I can do up some pretty
thorough work, and then
perhaps quit?

I hope you will have a
good time in W. and
not get badly reconstructed

I suppose they will want
manuscript for Utah book
by latter part of July.

I have at last finished
sorting up & ready to pack
sets of Utah & Wyoming.

I shall send a box to
you, enclosing the foreign
parcels. I have selected the
Utah set (fullest) for B.C.

lower set for Boissier &
Maximowicz, will specify the
items with the parcel. I

have still to select from the
surplus for Pain's Museum.
There will be a small set
in the box for Olney, and

perhaps will send Peltandra set
to you. I have now but
2 of the smallest sets left
