Spring Lake, Utah
Aug 4th 1875.

My Dear Dr. Gray: I have just
got back from a trip to
Salt-Lake. Had a nice turn
a swim in the Dead Sea.
On my return I went up
Arm Fork Cañon a wild
rough country but inferior
in botanical interest to
Mt. Nebo. At Salt Lake
I met Capt F M Bishop. the
bot. collector in S Utah. I
am to meet him again &
look over his collection.
At the Utah Museum I found
some scrappy plants sent by
Wm. Johnson from Knappton

and get permission to pick
out anything of interest. Of
course I did not leave much
among them is the enclosed Dalea
which I hope will turn out
D. Fremontii, a good fl
specimen of Thripsea Utahensis
a nice Polygala. Some other
things of which I will make
out a mail parcel

At Salt Lake I got hold
of a copy of Watson which
helped me to straighten out
some things. We will be glad
to see nice fl specimens of
his Lonicera Utahensis which
will require some slight
correction of his description.
but it is very near L. ciliata
I shall get good seeds
glad to know Aspl. Beckwithii

I have good ripe fr of
A. glareosus I send 2 seeds

I am now arranging to make
a Camp near foot of Mt Neb
where I shall put in most
of my time till next
Mr Greene who leaves Colorado
for California next month I
have invited to visit me here
I hope he will come.

I shall soon have good seed
of Peraphyllum from Siler
I hope also for Symphoricarpos
longiflorus from St George but
I fear Monoptilon will miss
again as the season was dry
but I wrote for it & your
locally - to a son of Mr Whinn
I see this Aspidium which
excited me so is only A. Lanchitzii
which Watson got
