My dear Dr Gray

I am about
finishing up my lessons work
here. have concluded to leave
for San Francisco on 4th prox.
we now have frosty nights
& clear pleasant days
fruit still abundant. Should

Salt Lake we stay there on
the day after Oct 1st address
San Francisco.

I have concluded not to
put up sets of plants this
season. as the number of spaces
is small. not over 100. and I
think nothing quite new

So I shall have them all
boxed & sent to Liverpool
to wait my return next fall.
I pack out a few sent by
mail parcel to you, which may
be of some interest or in regard
to which I have some doubts.
The No used are only provisional.
Among them is an illustrated
series (No 6.) showing the gradation
between Cercocarpus ledifolius Nutt.
& C. microcarpus Watson. They
certainly run together.

I am sending Baekhouse a
large supply of Spiraea cespitosa
& think he can manage it
by making the bracelets strike
right. I still hope to send
you an open letter for publication
"Summer Botanizing in the
Westward."

I have boxed up what
Indian things I have for
Museum, but am not quite
certain how to address them
Dr Palmer now in San Diego
talks of coming on here and
go down to St George to winter
to dig Indian mounds &
go over to Moqui. I have
encouraged his plan, and
