 see it myself. It looks quite  
 different from G. setulosa which  
 has clear white flowers (like a Burthia)

Davenport April 3<sup>d</sup> 1877

I have received your last letter &  
 Postal in reference to Echidnocea &c  
 I have no distinct recollection of the  
 plant but think it was gathered near  
 Crofton, have written to Lemmon about  
 it. The specimens are scant 3 or 4  
 whole ones besides the one sent you.  
 I have picked out some of the repeat  
 seed in hopes you can make it grow.  
 If your specimen is not sufficient for  
 Herb. & Kew. I will send more, all  
 plants now sent <sup>to the last</sup> will be under the  
 regular distributing number. I can  
 now send any special order or genera  
 you may be working at so save the  
 trouble of a bulky box.

I concluded the Utah Echinopspermum  
 was  $\delta$  because I was gathering seed from  
 old stalks while the new leaves were  $\delta$   
 densely clustered with fresh leaves  
 quite different from the Rocky Mt sp  $\delta$   
 I sent you one of The roots by mail &  
 calling attention to it, perhaps it was  
 overlooked? I think I could not be  
 mistaken as to its perennial character  
 which seemed constant not annual
