Davenport, Iowa, Sept 13<sup>th</sup> 1878.

Dear Dr Gray

I just reached home after  
a very tedious & difficult trip by the  
frontier. via Saltillo. Monterrey Laredo  
San Antonio. Left San Luis August 3<sup>d</sup>  
by Mexican cart train 3<sup>d</sup> day out  
was attacked by inflammation of eyes  
which kept me nearly blind most of  
the way across the desert to Saltillo.  
stopped at the latter place 10 days to  
revert. then by easy stages via Monterrey  
& Laredo to San Antonio. I managed  
to pick up some nice things on the  
way as the season was unusually favorable  
abundant rain &c will pack out a  
few things to send before long. we are  
now expecting Dr Engel & wife to make

us a visit on return from Minnesota  
expect a good time. I am busy  
laying out things to examine.  
The Patnons are well, and laying  
great plan to entertain the Engels.

Please send me as soon as possible  
by mail, all the late issued botanical  
matter, especially Watson Index &  
your Synopsis, with list of the same  
(including Postace) which I will remit  
by Postel order. Say to Watson I have  
good fruiting specimens of Platanus Mexicanus  
I saw in Herb. Engel, what I took to be  
P. Wrightii Watson. I have also leaf  
specimens of Populus Mexicanus, from  
Saltillo. I am not certain if the Populus  
at San Luis is the same, but I have  
full material for determining.

Found Mr Parry well not hearing from  
me for over a month had been quite  
anxious, our Academy in new building  
is splendid, a room has been fitted up  
for my special benefit. Last night  
freezing. I was very sorry
