

336 *Eupatorium scorodonioides* Gray n. sh. A low growing (1-2 ft) branching shrub, in rocky hills near San Luis Potosi. May & June. 2 varieties? one with smaller deltoid leaves, the other growing in shade? more flaccid, abundant specimen 30-40 of both varieties?

349 *Brickellia hymenochlora* n. s. Gray fort hills near San Luis Potosi. May & June. slender, mostly simple stems 6 inch to 18 inches high with a knobby & fibrous root.

353 *Barrroeta setosa* Gray n. gen. has the habit of the rock crevice *Brickellia*'s. old leaves persistent ^{with buds} on lower stem, and recent fresh shoots. my largest specimen 1 foot high much branched. did not see it growing. Mts S.E. of San Luis Potosi. August Palmer. I have sent a scrap in letter to Barrroeta, what about a "2^d Species"?

359 *Byelorica oppositifolia* n. s. fr. A low spreading shrub with slender branches rocky hills near San Luis Potosi. specimen scanty May.

362 *Brickellia thyrsoiflora* n. sh. a densely branched leafy suffrutescent plant 1-3 ft. August. Mts S.E. of San Luis Potosi.

363 *Brickellia Parryi* Gray n. sh. Vigately branched shrub 1-3 ft. high Mts S.E. of San Luis Potosi. August.

384 *Aster Plesinensis* Gray n. sh. 8-18 inches high, border of brooks in Mts S.E. of San Luis Potosi.

382 *Aster divaricatus* L? 1-2 ft Mt woods. S.E. of San Luis Potosi. August - Sept

395- *Erigeron Palmeri* fr. n. sh. 12-18 inches simple
fl. stem radical leaves roots lanceolate with
long tapering petioles coarsely serrate apparently perennial?

404-408-412 *Baccharis naniflora* 1-3 ft high much
branched, common in gravelly ridges near border of
stream San Luis Potosi, June. variable in size &
growth according to location.

410 *Baccharis Potosina* n. sh. gray upper border of stream
8-18 inches high June (abundant)

411 *Baccharis Seemannii* gray n. sh. 12-18 inches
strict stems simple or few branches long branched
roots with fibres near stream San Luis Potosi June

423 *Gnaphalium* 12-18 inches with long horizontal
roots set with fibres high Mts S. S. of San Luis Potosi
August & Sept

446 *Zaluzania molliissima* fr. n. sh. shrub 3-5 ft
in gravelly ridges S. & East of San Luis Potosi
Sept

447 *Lindheimeria Mexicana* n. sh. ! prostrate branching
with ascending stems thick knotted roots, brought by
Palmer from the interior near valley Mexico apparently
subalpine.

448 *Calea alba* gray n. sh. a densely branched
suffrutescent plant 2-3 ft high in gravelly soil near
San Luis Potosi August

450. Pereskium tenellum³ n sh low branching plant
4 st. feet near San Luis August
- 462 Encelia microphylla n sp. gray branching shrub 10-15 in.
gravelly hills near Sattello Mexico August
463. Helianthella Mexicana n sh gray 6-18 inches
Valley of Mexico. Palmer July
466. 3-4 ft. Mt slopes
near San Luis Potosi August
- 474 18-24 inch savanna &c
vicinity of San Luis Potosi July
- 475 12-18 inches growing in
dense clumps. edges of savanna San Luis Potosi August

547. Perezia (Acaustia) gravelly slopes near San Luis Potosi
12-20 inches high much branched. flowers early in
Spring, & again in late fall. (named in Herb. Schaffner
Truxis Potosina "an st n sh". I wonder that Benth
should incline to put Acaustia in Truxis. very different
in habit & everything.

1106 Zexmenia graphalioides n. sp. Gray.
Palmer on route to Tampico December. late grave lvs
of plant - 1-2 ft! post fl.

1108 Calea tomentosa n. sp. Palmer Supplementing Dec
only a branch with single post fl. in coll apparently
a low branched shrub (r like 466 Zaluzania mexicana)
