I collected plenty of nice fl. specimens
of Blanda California at same
locality.

I will send you soon all the
desirable or doubtful Compositae
I have picked up this season.

Pentyle amaryi var. midz was
splendid on the falls 2 weeks ago.
Very dry here yet. Good time for
dry botany!
