your activity.

Laurifera Parryi has just gone  
out of flower, and later the leaf will  
show. I would like this coming Spring  
to get on the line of the Atlantic &  
Pacific RR through North Arizona  
if I could get a RR pass. I must  
try & make a raid on the Boston  
officials, & perhaps you can help  
me. I spent xmas at Chico
