see the light. Kellogg is taken up
entirely in his tree & shrub sketches
and has quit publishing in sp. '1 he
is also physically weak, & broke down
We do not hear from Greene. he was
involved in a disagreeable church squabble
in which the bishop sided against him
but since has been honorably reconciled
but it seemed to switch him off from
botany. he had not at last accounts
got his appointment as botanical lecturer
at University. Bolander applied for it
but has lost all his standing in Cal.
I am now negotiating for transfer of my

collection - I think to the Soc. Stat. Museum
and Apr College - if convenient with it
will leave our feet to go when I return
I please a lunch of I see weather
since New Year
