It is only by accident that any of Kellogg's types can be found among the rubbish of the Cal. Acad Herb. and your note & specimen is the 1st I know of it. ^(i.e. Acetabularia Vealchii) I have not the least doubt that it is a var of A. bicolor. (I enclose herewith San Diego specimen that approximates it).

As showing a tendency to variation it rather confirms my view of A. Clevelandii also coming into the same, but you have the only specimen to show, and Mr Cleveland still insists that it is distinct?

I have just turned to Kellogg's Description of A. Vealchii. which is "more duo"!!
