

Kew Gardens Oct 21<sup>th</sup> 1884

Since writing you I have seen  
a Beechey specimen (leaf only)  
of Arctostaphylos Hookeri Don?  
which is clearly Xerobothrys venulosa Nutt.  
If all these allied species are  
to stand as distinct from A. pungens  
I would propose as follows  
No 3 Arctostaphylos humilis Nutt  
with synonym A. acuta Nutt  
Journal Phila Acad. (1841)

No 4 Arctostaphylos venulosa  
~~Xerobothrys venulosa~~ Hartweg (1826) no  
Arctostaphylos Hookeri Don  
A. Hookeri (Gray in part) Syng 7C  
etc &c sc

As Nuttall's species are fully represented  
in accessible specimens, and  
his descriptions are clearly applicable  
to the plants. They should stand in  
preference to Doris which are not  
clear
