

Davenport, Iowa July 9th 1886

Dear Dr Gray

You may think from
the enclosed that I have broken
out with the old complaint, but
I hope the facts in the case
will bear me out.— I have
now been several years watching
this thing, and now after full material
has come into my hands I could
not well resist the temptation
of putting the results in print.
I should probably have had it
in a little different shape if I
had not previously corresponded with
Greene and got somewhat committed
to his views, besides wishing to do
what is just & right. and hearing
that he would be absent for a month
or more exploring the Santa Barbara
Islands. I had to act without advising,

with him - so to avoid any cause
of disagreement. I associate his name
with mine in establishing the genus
Haplocladus! I think you will certainly
agree with me in the necessity of
the case and though I may not have
put it in the best shape it will
have to stand. That you & Watson
can both judge for yourself - (if you
have not yet received Brackets specimen)
I enclose a scrap exhibiting the

essential characters - I will afterwards
send copies of papers for distribution.
Besides this Brackets sends full sized
plaster of Eriog. Scalare Watson.,¹ and
Chrysanth. Fernandina from a new locality.
I have just had a visit from
Mr Wm Fawcett. ent. at British Museum
who hopes to call on you on his
way home next week.

I have been looking to receive
from you a Bob Card of which

I have seen notices (Ranunculaceae)?
to issue with Watson X(II)

I have been keeping quiet at
home trying to keep cool. will make
a short trip next month to Wisconsin
I have been endeavoring to write to
Watson for some time to acknowledge
the Eriog. Desiderata s. study sent
by him. also to give particulars
of the death of a mutual friend
Prof S. S. Sheldon!
