Dear Dr. Gray. -

Yes: my Ranunculus Ludovicianus is the very same of which I sent you akenes named R. adscendens. (I had forgotten that there was an R. adscendens already).

The akenes sent you were some that lay loose in the paper, therefore the very largest and maturest.

The petals are of the same number as in R. Californicus, i.e. 10-15.

I wait to see what you will do with our 5-petaled "R. Californicus" which certainly is entirely distinct from the many-petaled one; and I am trusting it will prove to be identical with R. occidentalis. Nutt.
