In the months of August and September 1900 I collected some beetles, mostly small specimens, in Surinam, as well on the coast as in the inland. On my way back to Europe by the English Royal Mail, I visited Barbadoes and stayed there for a fortnight, in which time I also collected some Coleoptera. Dr. H. J. Veth has been kind enough to classify this collection and to determine a part of the species.
