far, represented by 254 individ-  
uals, the bulk of which are from  
the collections of Dr. Edw. Palmer, Dr. Geo  
Vasey, and Messrs. Parryson, Mohr,  
Curtiss, Orcutt, McJones, Lemmon,  
Green, Pringle and Addison Brown (balled  
plants).

I have beside about 200 mss.  
letters from U.S. and Mex. botanists  
noting the sp. in their localities, these  
to aid in geographic distribution of  
sp.

As literature I have DeCandolle  
Prod. Bot Mex Bound. Bot. Calif. Jour  
Contrib. XIII, XIV. Boissier's Icones Euph. &  
minor works.
