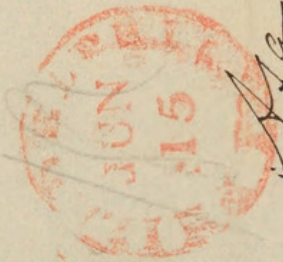
Dear Dr. -
