My dear Professor Watson:

Thank you
for your prompt reply con-
cerning the two *Ranunculi*. I
had named the Mancos *Ranunculus*
R. glaberrimus? and had sent it to
a friend who thought it *R. Lemmonii*.
I shall inclose a specimen of *R.*
Macaulayi in flower and some of the
seeds (which fall off when dry) that
I obtained four years ago on Mt.
Kendall of the San Juan Mts.
It differs somewhat from the
Elk Mts. specimen. I thought it
the type as I found it in the
range of mountains to which it
was credited. I was very glad
that my specimens were acceptable
to the Herbarium.
