Thank you  
for your prompt reply con-  
cerning the two Ranunculi. I  
had named the Manos *Ranunculus*  
*R. glaberrimus?* and had sent it to  
a friend who thought it *R. Lemmonii*.  
I shall inclose a specimen of *R.*  
*Macaulayi* in flower and some of the  
seeds (which fall off when dry) that  
I obtained four years ago on Mt.  
Kendall of the San Juan Mts.  
It differs somewhat from the  
Elk Mts. specimen. I thought it  
the type as I found it in the  
range of mountains to which it  
was credited. I was very glad  
that my specimens were acceptable  
to the Herbarium.
