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My dear Gray

I had just posted a letter to you when I received yours of the 10th Dec - the documents from the Smithsonian are just come to hand May I thank you then in reply to your question - If your *Chomelia andrewsii* is more than 2-celled I should certainly put it into *Guetardella* - the three genera *Chomelia*, *Antirhoea* and *Guetardella* are very closely allied but the American *Chomelia*s at least have I believe never more than 2 cells.

You will see in my flora that I have quite adopted your view of *Guetardella* whose characters I think are even more constant than you did - for the corolla of *Amorpha* is certainly I should say / not valvate
