I think I have a sp.² of a new Myrtle - no fls. nor fruit - shall get both another season - if you like I'll send them - may be you would recognize them or something else for which I mistake it in my conjecture.

I send you a few sp.² from Colorado - some I recognize others I do not - of convenient size now, and any thing you wish I may be able to get for you.

Enclosed are a few hasty remarks or hints relative to our bulbs &c.
