Dear Mr. Bartlett 1809.

Your no. 1265, "small, pink, glutinous, on bark" I do not find. Do you recollect whether I told you that it was Hypsilobium fragiformis L.?

1042, on Diospyros. This was not a fungus.

913 On Crataegus Marshallii. This was a Rosellia but the hycundia only were developed and the acicidia had not begun to show. Therefore the species cannot be settled although it may perhaps be one of the forms put in Rosellia lacerata.

1061. On Vaccinium arboreum
My recollection is that this was Rhytidina Vaccinii Dr.

1055. Impossible to say
to which of the three species
of Rhytidina of Schwentzky,
R. primi, R. dicincoloma and
R. relatives, this belongs. None
of them have been described
with mature fruit. Your
specimen is also sterile.

919. On Glex opaca. This is
apparently Rhytidina
carticula B. & K., but sterile.

892. On Syconia, probably
R. decolorans Fr., but even
that species comes near
R. andromedae (R.) Fr. Your
892, however, is not typical
R. andromedae at any rate.

1573. I still think that this
is Clavaria Botrytis.

1559. Have not been able
to make out certainly
what this species is.
