Lepidoderma tigrinum, Bartlett

Mr. N. H. R. Thaxter. This appears to be the same as the "Chondriodermia form" previously sent by me and mentioned in Monog. Mus. p. 106. Notice the *Physarum* very large yellow columella.

Physarum (compresso)

Chocoma, N.H. 1907. This is the same as other specimens from the White Mts. sent you which I understood you to place in P. compressum but I may have misunderstood you. The stalk is calcareous throughout and one sees a central lime nucleus in some cases but not always.

On Cladonia, Chocoma.

This was growing in dry weather and I do not think that I had found something interesting. Unfortunately it would not ripen after gathering and is almost too immature to tell what it is. Can it possibly be a state of Baekmannia rubiginosa? I do not know Physarum rubiginosum but this does not answer to the description of that species.
