my notes or specimens  
will be acceptable

Have also, through  
the Stools on your Flora of  
N.U. Though I am not qualified  
to find & criticize I doubt  
not it is a most excell-  
ent work & trust you  
may be spared to complete  
it.

 high mtns & blooms at least  
 a month earlier than its late)

 White. Inside of corolla lobes  
 purple. Wet soil. Subalpine

 Not in full bloom when Coll.

- 1658 *Monotropa Hypopitys*  
 Favorty thick timber on low

 Flowers not seen. Santiam River  
 Linn Co. Col. in winter)

White. On rocks Santiam Riv.  
Lincoln Co. Marsh,
- 1580 *Fraseria nitida*; Bent (as)  
Blue on hill back of Dallas  
Perennial! (T. speciosa - the  
common form - grows for several  
at sprouts (4 or 5 at least) when  
blooms & invariably dies.)

Deep blue purple 1<sup>2</sup> - 2<sup>2</sup> much  
branched at root. Rocky hill
