Mrs. Meyer,

I will send you in a few days half a dozen sets, being all of the smaller sets that I have. The ferns are not named but you will recognize them. You can do just whatever you please with them and if they only yield one dollar a set I will be satisfied. If on examining them you think they are not worth your troubling yourself about, you can either return them to me at my expense or distribute them where they will be acceptable. I have eight of the larger sets of 100 specimens (50 ferns & 50 plants) remaining and in them the specimens are all named. I would dispose of them now for \$200 a set as I would like to get them out of my cabinet where they take up too much room.

I was pleased to hear that Mr

Cassino had made such a generous atonement for his fault. We are to have no more of Emerson's work. He has given it up on account of a situation which he has obtained and Mr. Fay's will finish the plates. I think you will be pleased with his work as he has surprised those of us here who did not know of his fine editorial abilities.

I am confined to the house today by a heavy cold, and have been trying to answer a few of the many letters that have accumulated during the past two weeks but my eye will not permit me to do much.
