

Mexican plants received from Mr. Gentry, June, 1940  
determined at the Gray Herbarium by I.M. Johnston

- 4761 *Jacquemontia Pringlei* var. *glabrescens* Gray, but evidently specifically distinct from *Pringlei*. Standley has called this, (and other forms) *J. oaxacana* but I do not believe he is correct in so doing
- 4915 *Tagetes subulata* Lev. & Lex. or close to it.
- 4844 *Ditaxis tinctoria* (Millsp.) Pax. & Hoff. or at least what passes as this species.
- 4756 *Ditaxis adenophora* Gray, very similar to the type/
- 4841 *Cissus* Nothing at all close to this in the Gray Herbarium
- 5956 *Mimosa* very different from any thing in the Gray Herbarium  
Is "encinalensis" a well formed name? It is Spanish with a Latin ending. Why not English with a Latin ending "oakgrovensis"? Encinal is not a proper noun.
