Dear Sir, I have received several botanical pamphlets from you and Mr. Watson for which I am very much obliged. If there are any Colorado plants growing in this vicinity you would like let me know and I will be very glad to collect them for you.

I send by mail to-day a package containing my only duplicate of #560 *Astragalus Brandegei*, Torr., collected in 1878 and specimens of #870 collected two weeks ago and named by Mr. Redfield *Thermosma Texana* — They are from the Soda Spring Ledge within half a mile of Canon City — It grows in close, dense tufts in clefts of the rocks.
