



Utica, 31 October, 1912

Dear Mr. Drane: -

I was glad to get your note. Mr. P. and Miss P. and Mrs. Taxa are all here having come safely ten days or more ago, and are all in excellent health. The baby grows finer every day. I am glad to hear that Mrs. Coolidge's vitality is so good, and trust it and the doctor's health may continue.

The Bog-raphus I picked on Davis St. on the north side, along the stone wall border beside the tennis courts. I have no record of the date; unless likely you have that. - The scene along the Gray Hart is good indeed. Good things seem to be gradually coming its way now. I have three or four hundred more plants for the Clue Herb. Collected the latter part of the summer, chiefly in Catt Co., also some plants for the Gray Herb. Chequy, collected yesterday this fall which I shall deposit in the season. Farwell writes me he is about to run over N.Y.B.C. plants before they are distributed, and I presume he will be all satisfied with his determinations. // After being at the Glen Ho. - where I did some good things on the west side of Mt. W. just at Spots of Shrub, Raymond and Huntington Ranges, and visiting of the seldom visited Distal Pool near Cedar Creek Falls - I had a few days at Randolph, then a night at Mt. Hart. and the next day a beautiful walk with a friend from Mt. W. down over Broot Spur, Mt. Motivation, Davis, Giants Stair, Resolution, and camped to Bonis and hence to Bartlett, 23 miles in a day, a trip full of interest and variety. Work here is going well and my classical museum is nearly made up to be opened to the public next week. Regards to all, A.P.
