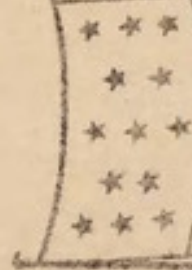
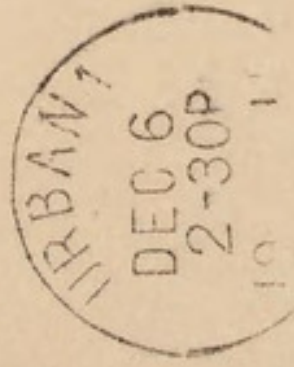


Urbana, 5 Dec., 1915
