

Tatana, 15 May, 1916

My dear Mrs. Drane: -

Your letter and question have come and I am at a loss what to reply. I have no recollection whatever of such a label or specimen of Hilella muda or of usual circumstances should have led me to give it to you. Are you sure it is in my writing? I am often forgetful of things, but I don't see why I might not have missed notice. I shall be as much interested as you if the mystery can be cleared up! It can't be any specimen of mine, for I never myself collected in West Kentucky, though I have in Herkimer Port and Herkimer Old Town. Nor did I ever exchange with Eaton, though I remember he had had a sheet or two of this from someone else. And if it had been in my book, it would have gone into the N.Y.B.C. herbarium rather than the Gray, being from N.E. I don't know how to explain it. — Mr. Had a pleasant call on the Treleams yesterday, and they signified kindly for you. They mother writes of the travails of Randolph where she now is. I shall have time for the rest on 14 June, if all goes well. We have not our house here for next year. Alfred Moore has written me of his plans which I hope may go well. It is time he got something permanent. Give our best regards to Mrs. Drane, and with all our wishes for you. I am yours sincerely, A.S.P.
