Dear Mr. Deane:-

A last time type breakfast to let
you know of my safe return from N.S. where
I was for 3 weeks, leaving the other boat-
time for the rest of the summer. We hauled
mostly from our base at Gannavick, and got
lots of things of interest, especially coastal
fauna. Day and Long and I found
two new mollusks for Schizaea, and I found

you a tiny bit herewith as a sample.

There were in the party while I was on it
H.L.F., Long, Binell, and Linder, and, for the
last few days of the time, White and Bean.
Evens and Hers were expected after I left.

Despite bad weather we collected loads of
material and had a fine trip. When I
see you next I will describe it in
detail, and you will doubtless hear of it
from H.L.F. at the Club.

I must now stop for this post.
