# IN FIRST PETRIFIED FOREST

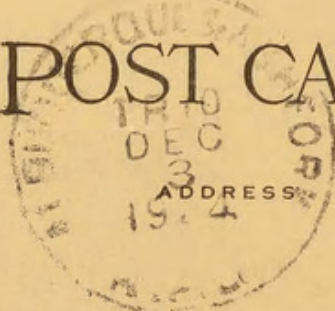
A view showing some of the scattered sections of the petrified trees in the first forest, six miles south of Adamana. The U. S. Government has set aside 25,000 acres of petrified wood as a natural monument which is under Government control. Petrified wood weighs over 150 pounds to the cubic foot.
