My dear Miss Day:-

I have been trying to look up those names in the Cat. Bry. & Pterid. of Pa. I fail to find any trace of the first four names (*Mollia viridula stenocarpa*, *Barbula unguiculata lanceolata*, *Barbula unguiculata stricta*, *Astrophyllum cuspidatum elatum*) except in the Pa. Cat. This may mean that my ~~xxx~~ index is incomplete or it may mean that the names are new.

The last name (*Amblystegium irriguum spinifolium*) appears in the second ~~xx~~ edition of W. P. Shimper's *Synopsis Musc. Europ.* (1876) page 713.

Am sorry that I can not say any more definitely in regard to the first four names.
